

2024-25 Mini-Grant Application

Application Deadline: October 14, 2024

Instructions

Thank you for your interest in the 2024-25 SEPA Mini Grant Program. The SEPA Mini Grant program was originally inspired by the Mini-Grant programs of the International Planetarium Society (IPS) and the Pacific Planetarium Association (PPA) in response to the negative impact the Covid-19 pandemic had on the planetarium community.

Two individual grants in the amount of \$1000 will be awarded this year. To apply, complete and submit the application by October 14, 2024. Grant recipients will be determined by the SEPA Mini Grants Committee, based on several factors and on a case by case basis. Above all, the planetarium must show a need for the grant and communicate a specific use for the funds. Preference will be given to submissions that are project based and that can possibly be shared with the larger planetarium community.

SEPA is the community of planetariums in Kentucky, West Virginia, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Georgia, Florida, Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, and all U.S. Territories off the southeastern coast of the U.S. Any planetarium can apply for a mini grant, but priority will be given to current SEPA members.

Awardees will be notified by Nov 1, 2024 and will be posted on the SEPA website.

Grant recipients will be asked to provide a brief report about your planetarium and how the SEPA Mini Grant was used, which will be posted on the website and appear in Southern Skies, the quarterly SEPA journal.
